Construction Manager Letter of Understanding

Subject: Article V – Subcontracting

The Committee was requested to provide an understanding on the application of Construction Managers as they pertain to the National Maintenance Agreements.

Conclusion

The Committee concluded that a Construction Manager is an entity that does not direct hire craft manpower but rather acts as an agent of an owner/client by way of, but not limited to, letting contracts and/or directing subcontractors for work performed under the National Maintenance Agreements. The Committee further concluded that in those instances where an entity is acting as an agent of the owner/client then the attached Letter of Understanding - Construction Manager Participation form shall apply and may be obtained through the administrative office of the NMAPC, Inc. or at www.nmapc.org.

The NMAPC Impartial Secretary/CEO will consider fully executing the aforementioned form only after it has been submitted to the NMAPC administrative office along with a detailed description of the applicable scope of work. A \$2,000.00 fee is applied to each executed Letter of Understanding - Construction Manager Participation form that a company signs, with the exception of any company that is currently a Governing member of The Association of Union Constructors (TAUC).

Finally, the Committee encourages all entities submitting an NMAPC Letter of Understanding – Construction Manager Participation form also consider requesting that the NMAPC designate the scope of work in question as a "Yellow Card Project". The "Yellow Card Project" designation process is outlined in NMAPC Policy Decision – Bulletin IV-6, entitled "Work Scope Determination Process for Application of the National Maintenance Agreement", and should be submitted in conjunction with the Construction Manager Participation form.
